Cyberstalking is the deliberate use of electronic communications (e.g., internet and social media) to harass and terrify someone else against their wishes. This could take the form of threats, defamation, false accusations, or other harmful behaviors. Such cyberstalking may even intensify to stalking beyond electronic communications. This training will examine the pathways, consequences, and interventions associated with cyberstalking behaviors through a threat assessment lens. Empirically based research findings and case study examples will be highlighted throughout this training.

Training Objectives

- Define cyberstalking and other related constructs.
- Learn about the causes, consequences, and interventions associated with cyberstalking behaviors.
- Identify and operationalize relevant warning behaviors for a Threat Assessment within stalking situations.
- Identify different typologies of stalking, including targeting of mental health professionals.
